

Sew it is Written – Three Sizes

All Sew Jenni patterns are designed to be used with teaching assistance during classes or retreats or after a teaching demonstration and are only very basic, step by step written instructions. You are welcome to keep this design as a reminder pattern to help you to create your own projects at home.

This Basic Beginner Pattern is a fast and easy sew using NON-FRAYABLE materials.

A5 Notebook Cover

Materials:

1 x 25cm x 36cm main vinyl
2 x 25cm x 12cm flaps
1 x 25cm x 20cm lining
.75cm Seam Allowance

A6 Notebook Cover

Materials:

1 x 17cm x 24cm main vinyl
2 x 17cm x 8cm flaps
1 x 17cm x 16cm lining
.75cm Seam Allowance

Flipbook Notebook Cover

Materials:

1 x 14cm x 22cm main vinyl
2 x 14cm x 10cm flaps
1 x 14cm x 10cm lining
.75cm Seam Allowance

LET'S GO!

Step One:

Cut out your 4 pieces

Step Two:

Lay your main vinyl right side up on the table in front of you

Step Four:

Place your flaps right side down on the short ends of your main fabric, paying attention to the direction of your fabric if needed.

Step Three: Flipbook Notebook Cover ONLY

Mark 3cm down from the top of your LEFT flat and 1cm IN from the middle edge. Cut a 7.5cm slit. Your cut will be 1cm from the middle edge of your flap and 1.5cm from your sewn edge of your work. Use Vinyl for these flaps to increase the strength and integrity of your notebook holder cut.

Step Five:

Place your lining fabric right side down on top of your flaps, in the centre of your main material, paying attention to the direction of your fabric if needed.

Step Six:

Clip and sew all around your fabric

Step Seven:

Trim your corners, do not cut any stitches.

Step Eight:

Turn the lining, and then turn your flaps, carefully pushing out all of your seams

Congratulations! You have now completed your Notebook Covers!
